SDG implementation and facilitate
legal arrangements

Steering Committee

- Responsible to provide policy directives, works to create a conducive policy environment, and builds partnerships for achieving the SDGs;



Implementation and Co-ordination Committee

- Responsible for guiding line ministries on mainstreaming the SDGs into national, provincial and local plans; arranging financial, human and technical resources by mobilizing internal and external resources, and coordinating between the public and private sectors, civil society and development partners;



Thematic Committees



Responsible for preparing SDG related plans, policies, programs, budget implementation, and monitoring and evaluation.



Coordination with sectoral government agencies such as ministries, the private sector, civil society, international organizations and other partners.

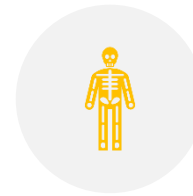
