What is PreventionWeb?

- Eight years old with initial objective of facilitating the work of & becoming the go-to place for DRR professionals
- In 2014: 1.2 million user sessions & 40,000 professionals use the site at least once a week
- 30,000 content items from 6,725 organisations (412 from private sector)
- 6,274 subscribers to daily/weekly updates
- It knows the DRR world and the DRR world knows it

What has it achieved?

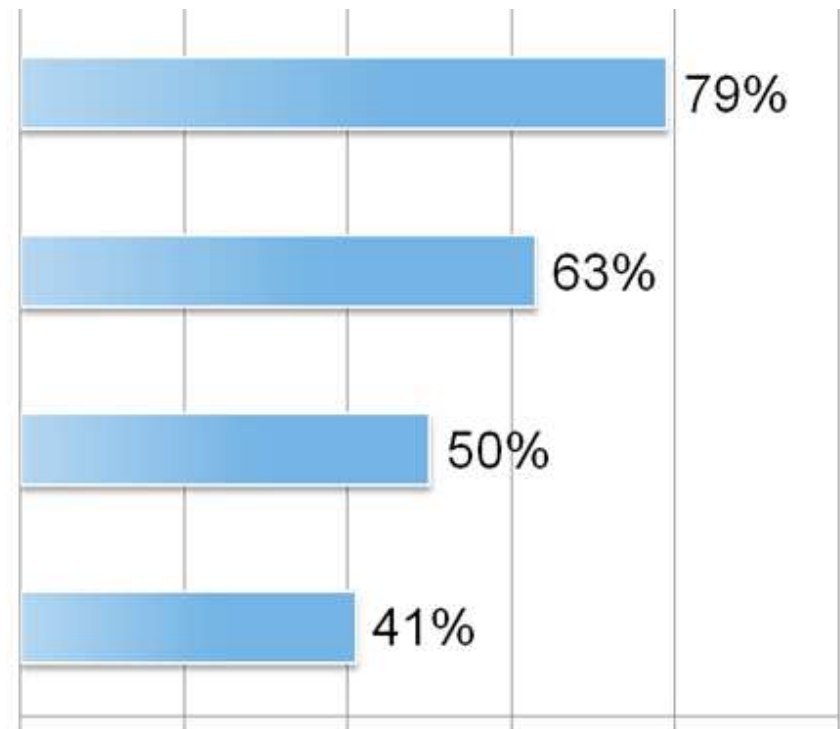
Improved my understanding of disaster risk reduction

Informed me of other areas in DRR that I was not aware of

Increased my engagement in disaster risk reduction

Helped me develop a DRR policy or strategy*

A major evaluation concluded need for more active knowledge brokering to add value; recommendations incl:

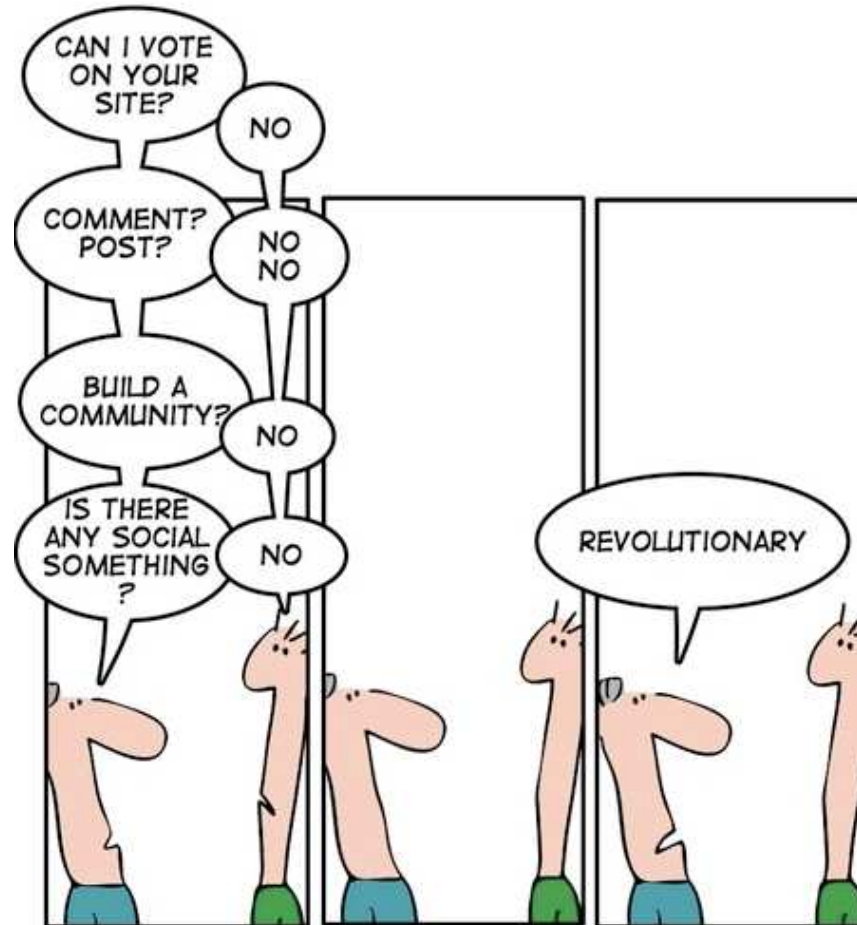
- ✓ Reduce number of services & focus on most important

- ✓ Increase number of languages & partners

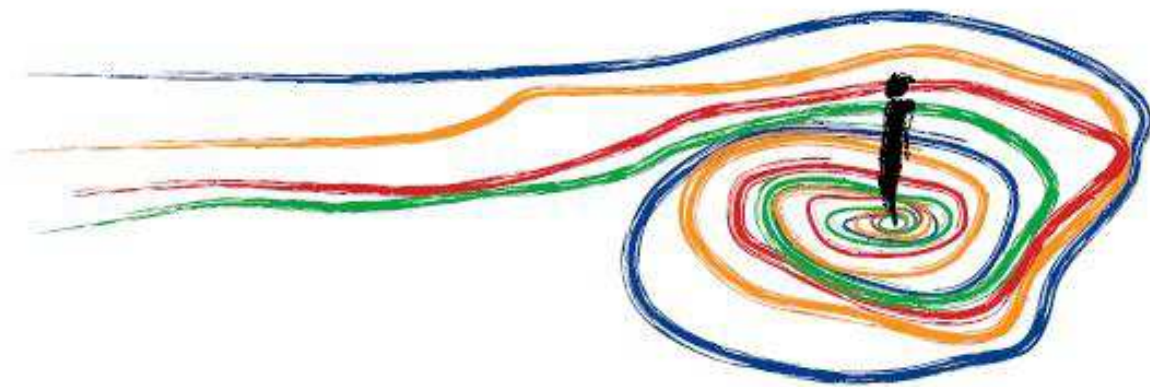
