Gendered Impact of COVID-19

- *Violence against women and girls has increased during lockdowns and curfews.*
- *Women are disproportionately affected by the **economic impacts** as they generally earn less and hold insecure jobs.*
- *Additional **unpaid care work** has fallen on women, with children out-of-school, greater care needs of older persons and overwhelmed health services.*

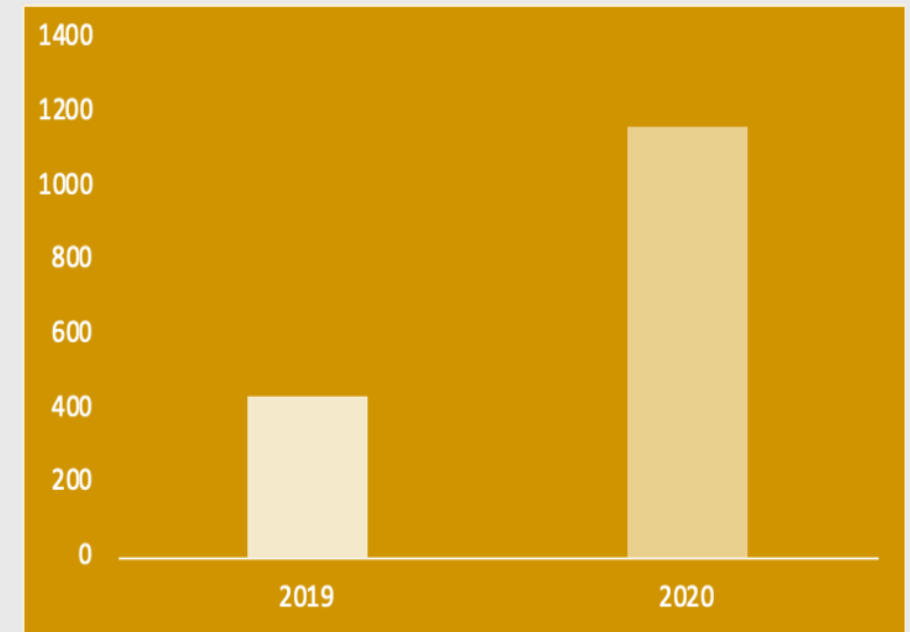


Women make up **70%** of
the health and social workforce.

Technology is not Gender Neutral

- ***Digital gender gap** - in two out of every three countries, more men use the Internet than women*
- *Women face **online harassment and threats**. Misogynistic posts and hate speech against women have increased during COVID-19.*
- *Women account for less than 10% of the **cybersecurity** workforce in Asia Pacific.*

Recommendations

- *Institutionalize **women's participation** in crisis preparedness and response.*
- *Support **women civil society** to reach those marginalized from mainstream relief and recovery programmes.*
- *Close the digital gender gap and support **women's digital citizenship**.*
- *Address gender blind spots in **cybersecurity** and **artificial intelligence**.*
