

## **Summary Report (based on progress report)**

### **Overall Summary**

UNGC partnered with MOGAHA of Korea to host the International Conference on the theme of “Government Innovation in Asia Countries: Experiences and Prospects,” held in Seoul on 24 October 2007. During its two sessions covering the sub-themes of *Key Values and Perspectives in Sustaining Government Innovation* and *Insights from Implementing Government Innovation*, the Conference invited Asia’s practitioners of successful public sector innovations to offer participants an opportunity to acquire information and exchange experiences in government innovations. Presided by H.E. Minister Park Myung-jae (MOGAHA), the Conference received more than 200 participants from diverse branches of government and academia all over Asia. The majority of participants replied in post-conference survey that they found the quality of the event extremely satisfactory, and that they would attend future UNGC events of similar kinds.
